

Afghan Democracy - Voting rights for all Afghans!

Everyone has natural rights and these rights have to be safed. The right to vote is such a natural law that has to apply in a democratic state like Afghanistan.

The Afghan law states that each Afghan whether living in Afghanistan or in exile, is eligible to vote and may participate in the elections if he/she

1. has completed eighteen years of age at the time of the election

2. has Afghan citizenship at the time of registration

3. is not deprived of any political and civil rights by an authoritative court

4. is registered in the voters registration list.

But what about the implementation?

The sad reality is that the majority of us Afghans does not have the opportunity to participate in the elections. Our right to vote is withheld from us and our voices go silent. If you are of the opinion that we should fight against this injustice, then support us by signing the declaration of consent.

At a rate of 50,000 votes, we will contact the Afghan Election Commission and stake our claim to vote.
